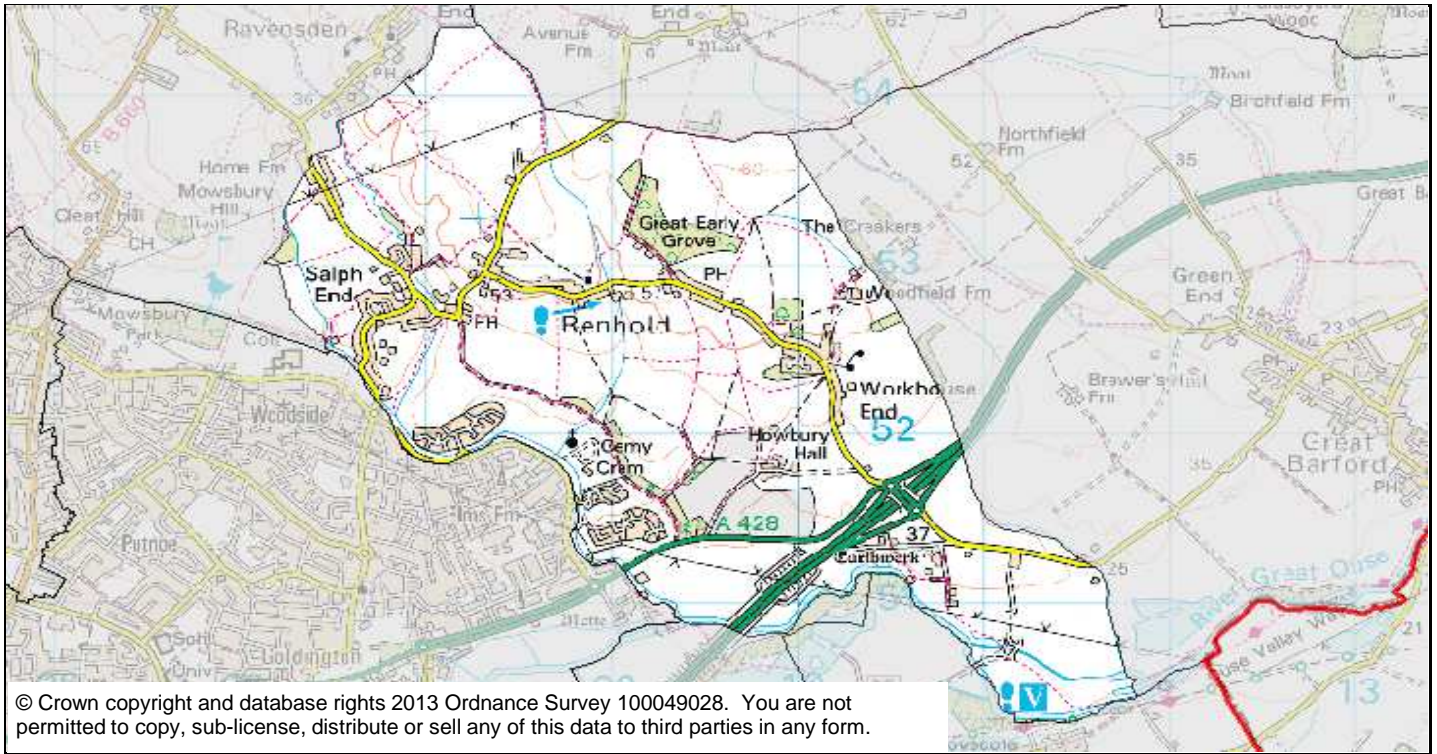

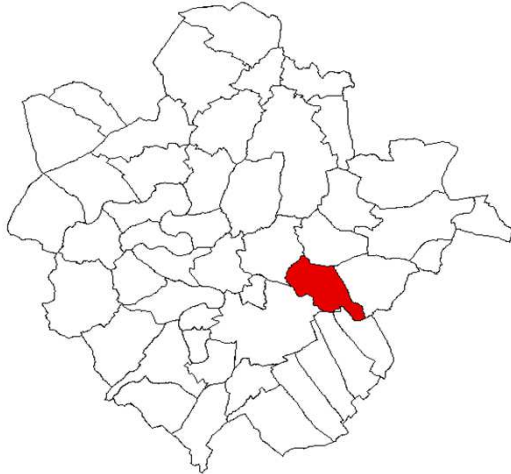

Located east of Bedford Town, Renhold's population increased by 1,000 between 2001 and 2011 due to new developments on the east side of Norse Road. Renhold has a slightly younger age profile than the Borough with 23% of residents aged 0-15. A broad mix of non-White British groups form 15% of the population.

While the majority of households are couples (63%) or one person households (20%), lone parents with dependent children form 9% of all households. Renhold has high home ownership (83%), with 8% of households renting from social landlords and 9% renting privately. Housing is predominantly detached (57%) and semi-detached (28%), and heated by gas (77%).

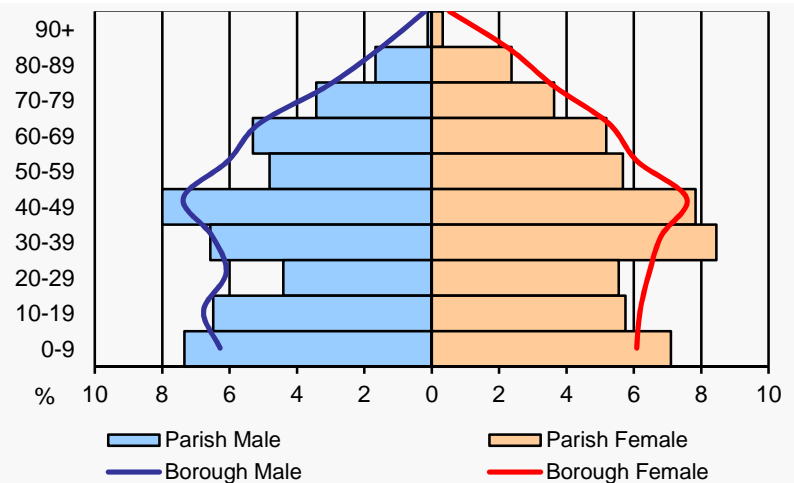
The overall economic activity rate among residents aged 16-74 is high (75%). Employment as managers, directors and in professional occupations (36%) slightly exceeds the rural parish average. The proportion of residents aged 16+ with degree-level qualifications (32%) is similar to the average for all parishes, and 15% have no qualifications.

Only 8% of households do not have a car, 42% have 2 cars, and 14% have 3 or more. Most people travel to work by car (80%), 8% work from home, 5% commute by train, but only 4% cycle or walk to work.
